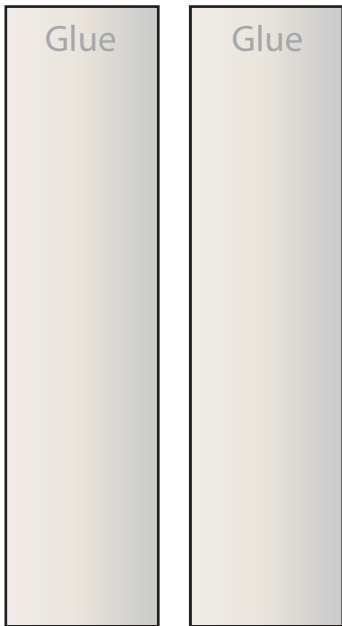
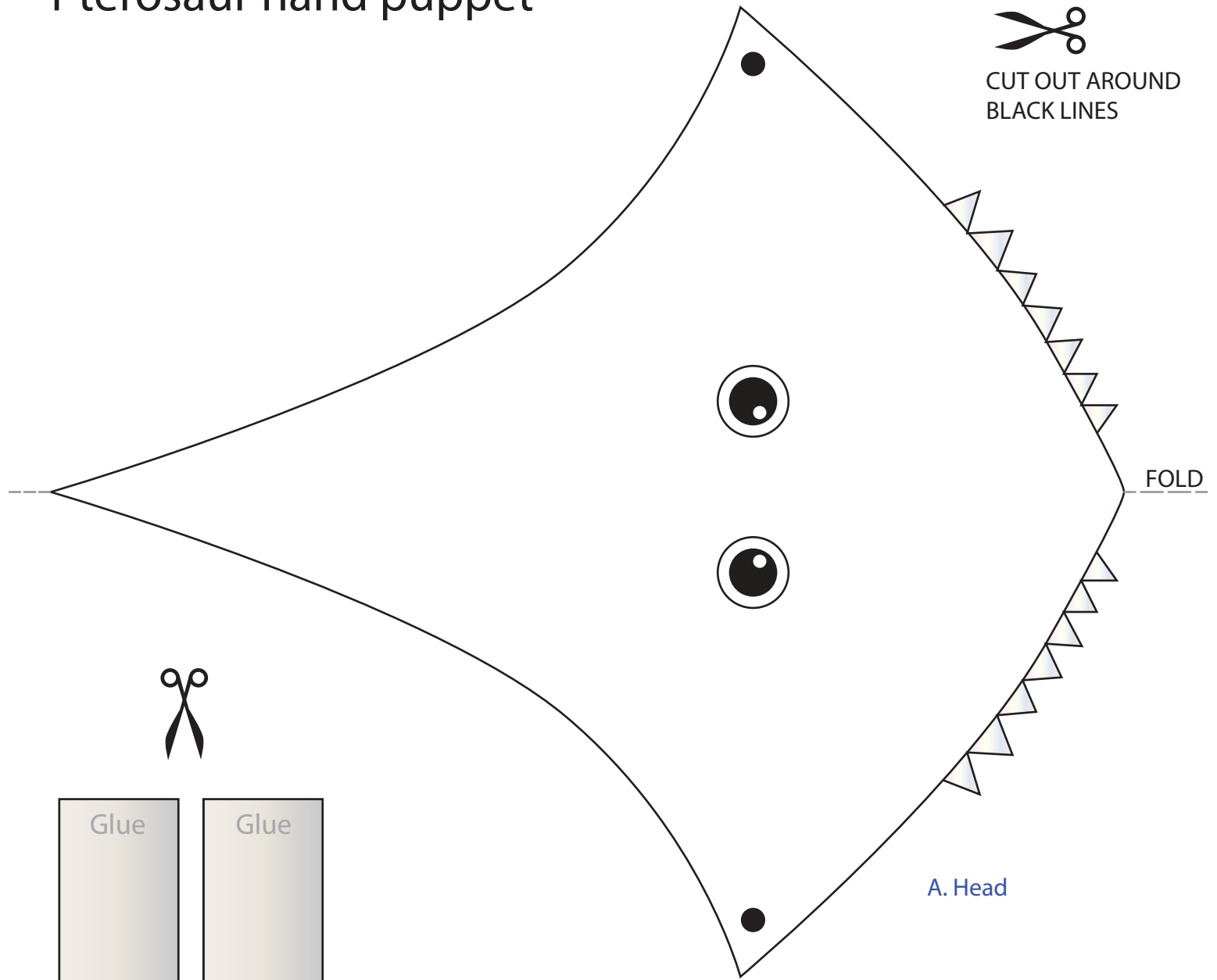


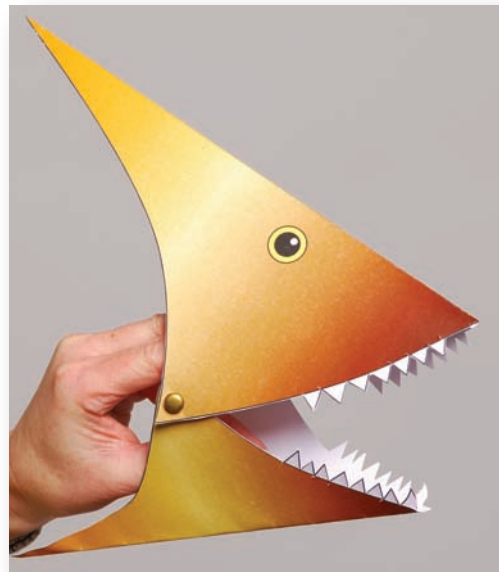

Pterosaurs were flying reptiles that lived between 210 million and 65 million years ago, the same period of time that dinosaurs were alive. The smallest pterosaurs were about the same size as a chaffinch, while the largest had a wingspan of 10 metres or more, making them one of the largest flying animals that has ever existed. Many pterosaurs had teeth and elaborate crests on their skulls.

This model can be printed on A4 paper, but for best results print on light card at A3.

1. Cut around the 4 parts of the model — you may need to get an adult to help you
 - A. Head
 - B. Lower jaw
 - C. Finger loops x 2
2. **Head and lower jaw:** Fold down centre lines
3. Pierce black dots with a pencil, then attach lower and upper jaws together with split pins.
4. Glue a finger loop to the head and another to the lower jaw
