This year's meeting will be held at Baskerville Hall Hotel, Hay-on-Wye. The inspiration for Arthur Conan Doyle's 'The hounds of the Baskervilles', the hotel sits within the Wye Valley Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty and at the northern most tip of the Brecon Beacons National Park.
