3. Other than as provided for at 4 below, no part of the Material may be traded, sold or in any other way supplied or made available to any third party on a commercial basis. Any reproduction on a commercial basis of extracts derived from the Material will require separate arrangements to be agreed in writing with BGS.
4. The Material, or extracts derived from the Material in non-manipulable electronic format (e.g. locked .PDF format), may be supplied or made available to any third party in connection with their operational activities as required in response to the emergency, **only if that third party has an existing BGS licence or other arrangement equivalent to the terms of this document, covering all of the Material to be supplied to that third party.** It is your responsibility to verify that such a licence/arrangement is valid before any part of the Material is supplied to such a third party.

Notwithstanding any other provision of this Agreement and for the avoidance of doubt, nothing in this Agreement shall prevent either Party from complying with its obligations under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 or any similar regulation. Wherever possible, and in accordance with any applicable Code of Practice issued with the legislation, either Parties will consult with the other Party before making any disclosure pursuant to the legislation in relation to this Agreement.
